Common Core ELA Test -- Part 3

Text-Analysis Response (2 to 3 paragraphs long)

STEP ONE = Identify a central idea in the text.

STEP TWO (implied) = Choose a writing strategy (used by the author) to discuss in your response. The second bullet under "Guidelines" in the directions lists 13 examples of writing strategies.

STEP THREE (the biggest part) = **Analyze** how the author's use of <u>one</u> writing strategy <u>develops</u> this central idea.

Must you include specific examples and direct quotes from the text to illustrate the writing strategy? **YES**, because you are writing a "text-based response."

Must you <u>explain how</u> these examples illustrate the writing strategy and <u>explain how</u> this strategy develops the central idea? **YES**, because you are **analyzing** the author's use of the strategy. **To analyze** means to examine parts to understand how they work together to create meaning as a whole.
